

Q1 What issues are you most concerned about when it comes to aging? Please select two:





Q2 How important do you think dementia supports are as a priority for the Ontario election?





Q3 How important do you believe it is for the Ontario government to invest in a dementia strategy?





Q4 Thinking about the health-care system and community services, which of the following issues do you think are most challenging for people impacted by dementia? Please select two:





Q5 How important do you think it for people impacted by dementia to have help connecting to information, care and services?





Q6 How important do you think it is it for families impacted by dementia to have access to adult day programs, in-home care and other supports that provide respite to caregivers?





Q7 Have you been diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease or another form of dementia, or are you caring for a family member/friend with dementia?





Q8 Have you or your family members received any kind of support or information from the Alzheimer Society?




