FluWatchers are part of national network of volunteers, labs, health care professionals and provincial and federal Health Ministries working to improve public health and monitor the spread of influenza (the flu).

FluWatchers receive weekly surveys asking if they have experienced flu or flu-like symptoms in the previous week. This data helps to show Canadians where the flu is happening. If outbreaks occur, it can provide health officials with an early warning help monitor the spread and incidence of the flu in the community.


Step by Step to Become a FluWatcher:






